

JENNIFER AND TODD 911 TRANSCRIPT

Dispatcher: 9-1-1, what's your emergency.
Jennifer: I just got beat up from my boyfriend
Dispatcher: Is he still there?
Jennifer: No, but he might be- I have- I- I got him out the car on the road and I'm afraid he's gonna come back.
Dispatcher: Okay, and you're calling from your home?
Jennifer: Yes.
Dispatcher: Your name?
Jennifer: Jennifer [blank]
Dispatcher: And whereabouts is your address?
Jennifer: Umm... [blank].
Dispatcher: And your boyfriend's name
Jennifer: Is [blank]... and he's on Highway [blank] somewhere.
Dispatcher: Walking you think?
Jennifer: Yeah.
Dispatcher: And he beat you up in the car and you-
Jennifer: Yeah
Dispatcher: And you got out of the car
Jennifer: He- he beat me up in the car cuz he was calling me a bitch and I slapped him on the face and he beat me up...
Dispatcher: Do you need an ambulance?
Jennifer: No, my face- it's just my face
Dispatcher: All right, umm... and his date of birth?
Jennifer: I don't know... I can't... um...
Dispatcher: How old is he?
Jennifer: He's [blank]... [blank]
Dispatcher: Okay... and you think he might make his way back to the house?
Jennifer: Yeah.
Dispatcher: Do you live together?
Jennifer: (Unintelligible) and we've got a gun here and I don't know how to use the gun and I don't- and it's not on safety and I'm just really afraid.
Dispatcher: Okay and does he have a key to get in?
Jennifer: No, he doesn't have a key, but he wrecked the door on my car. He- he'll break a window. He was trying to bust my door in, trying to break my window in.
Dispatcher: Okay. And are your doors locked now?
Jennifer: Yes.
Dispatcher: Okay. Let me get you some help. Hold on.
Jennifer: Hello?

Dispatcher: Jennifer?
Jennifer: Yeah.
Dispatcher: Hi, it's 9-1-1.
Jennifer: Uh-huh.
Dispatcher: The officers are coming from [blank]. Did you want me to stay on the phone with you?
Jennifer: Umm, no, but if I have to call you again, I will.
Dispatcher: Okay, umm- (unintelligible)
Jennifer: I think what I'm going to do because he told me that gun (cough) isn't on safety-
Dispatcher: Right.
Jennifer: And... I think I'm going to sit on the couch and if he comes in, cause I know he's going to be out to hurt me... (gasping) I might have to hurt him. (Gasping)
Dispatcher: Okay, why don't I just keep you on the phone until the officers arrive, okay?
Jennifer: Okay?
Dispatcher: All right. And let me know if anything is going on. I'll just be here and- and if you need to go do anything that's fine just leave the phone open.
Jennifer: Oh, okay
Dispatcher: All right?
Jennifer: Yeah.
Dispatcher: And I'll be here even if you don't here me talking.
Jennifer: Oh, okay.
Dispatcher: All right.
Jennifer: And if I need you you'll be on there?
Dispatcher: Yeah, I'll be on the line.

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
